Ticket Information

Tickets can be purchased at the box office outside the GA Dome on Saturday, 10/29/16.

Cost of Tickets

Saturday Prelims Only - \$22.00

Finals General Admission - \$26.00

Super Ticket (Prelims and Finals Combo) \$37.00

Chaperone Information

All band chaperones that travel with the band on the school buses will be given a ticket for prelims.

Road Crew Members

25 road crew members will receive field pass tickets for prelims. These passes will also allow access to the stadium during prelims only. If the band makes finals, we will receive an additional 25 finals passes for the road crew members.

Parking

Spectator parking is located in the Red Deck and Blue Lot and costs \$10 per car (no in and out privileges). There are also several additional parking opportunities surrounding the Dome. Please advise parents and boosters to arrive early to allow extra time to arrive to the stadium, especially during peak times.

Student Admission for Prelims

Since all students will be performing during prelims, they will be granted free admission during the entire prelim performances.

Band Student Responsibility:

1. Money for Concessions at Georgia Dome – please plan appropriately for possibly two concession stand opportunities and extra for Georgia Dome pricing.
2. Spending money for any extra concession stand food and/or BOA souvenirs

(Dinner break will completely depend on our finals performance time. This will most likely be concession stand dinner after our Finals performance.)

11:00 p.m. – Load buses and depart for Ola

12: 15 a.m. – Arrive at Ola – Turn in uniforms and dismissal

5:30 p.m. – Depart stadium as a group and walk back to buses

5:45 p.m. - Load buses and depart for Ola

7:00 p.m. – Arrive back at OHS – Turn in uniforms and unload all the trucks

**For students that would like to stay at the Georgia Dome to watch Finals, we will release you to your parents at the buses before we depart for Ola (@5:45). You will be responsible for the finals ticket back into the stadium. You will also be responsible for your own transportation home from the event.

Some more Information Regarding Ticket Pricing:

These ticket discounts are available **at the ticket window on the day of the event only** at all BOA Regionals and Super Regional Championships. These discounts may not be combined with other offers or discounts.

Bargains for Students and Children:

Children 10 and under admitted for free to general admission seats! Children 10 and under are admitted free for general admission seating at all Bands of America Championships (except the Grand National Championships).

Student Discount – Youth 11-18 years old: \$5 off any General Admission ticket type: individual Prelims, Finals or General Admission Day Pass. \$5 off Reserved Seat ticket type: individual Finals Reserved or Deluxe Day Pass (Deluxe Day Pass includes one General Admission Prelims and one Reserved Seat Finals ticket).

College Student Discount – \$5 off any General Admission ticket type: individual Prelims, Finals or General Admission Day Pass. \$5 off Reserved Seat ticket type: individual Finals Reserved or Deluxe Day Pass (Deluxe Day Pass includes one General Admission Prelims and one Reserved Seat Finals ticket). College Student ID required.

Adults Get Bargains too:

Seniors Discount - 62 years and over: \$5 off any ticket type, including Day Pass and Finals Reserved and Deluxe Day Pass.

"We Appreciate Your Service" Active Duty Military Discounts: \$5 off any ticket type, including Day Pass and Finals Reserved and Deluxe Day Pass, for any member of the active military and/or the spouse of an active duty military person. A service member or service member spouse may buy up to one additional Military Discount ticket. (Military ID required.)

CLEAR BAG POLICY FOR SPECTATORS & BAND RE-ENTRY

The Georgia Dome has adopted the NFL Clear Bag Policy. This requires new bag check and entry procedures upon arrival at the Georgia Dome. Outside of the performance flow, students and staff are considered spectators by the Georgia Dome and will be held to the Spectator Clear Bag Policy.

Spectators will be restricted to the following style and size bags at stadium plaza areas, stadium gates, or when approaching queue lines of fans awaiting entry to the stadium.

- Clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC bags that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- Clear plastic one-gallon freezer bag
- Small clutch bags / wristlets no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" with or without a handle or strap can be taken into the stadium without one of the clear plastic bags
- Exceptions will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at a gate designated for this purpose
- A Bag Check Tent, provided by the Georgia Dome, will be available for spectators on a first come, first served basis.
- Prohibited items include, but are not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size.
- Clear bag policies have been adopted in recent years by the NFL and other professional sports leagues and stadiums across the country to create a safer fan experience while also getting people through the lines and to their seats quickly and efficiently.
