Ola High School Marching Band Contract

Yes! Please enroll our family member in the OHS Mustang Marching Band for the fall season. We realize he or she must meet all attendance, conduct, and academic requirements in addition to fulfilling any financial commitment to the band and/or school to be eligible to participate.

We understand that because marching band is an extra-curricular activity, student membership in the band is left to the discretion of the director. Failure to follow the guidelines of the OHS student behavior code or other policies outlined in the band handbook can result in disciplinary action or dismissal from marching band without a refund.

We understand that we are expected to pay the first payment as a commitment fee (which is nonrefundable) via cash/check/credit card (PayPal on the band website only) or Band Individual Account by the deposit due date, so the band may begin making plans for me to join the program. Should we fall behind at any time on payments, it could result in dismissal from the group. We are aware that marching band fees are not refunded for any reason.

In signing this contract, we are stating that we have reviewed the band calendar and are aware of the dates that the student must attend for band camp, regularly scheduled rehearsals, and all performances. We have also read the financial obligation form and are aware of our financial responsibilities.

We will work by the belief that hard work is necessary for success. Our member will make every effort possible to respect the staff, chaperones, and fellow band members and work towards creating a positive environment throughout the season. Our member is genuinely interested in being part of something GREAT and will work toward excellence while in the Marching Band.

We understand that if Mr. Manson and the other staff members see a decline in work ethic and belief in these ideals, our student will be subject to dismissal from the OHS Marching Band. We take responsibility for our part in the success or the failure of our marching band and can accept criticism, positive and negative, as efforts to better our band. We know that all students are here by choice and have committed my time and energy to all rehearsals and performances.
